Teaching (ARPIT) and has identified SPA as one of the National Resource Centres for architecture faculty. UGC has notified equivalence of ARPIT as a refresher course for career advancement of faculty, a major and unique initiative of online professional development of 15 lakhs higher education faculty using the MOOCs platform SWAYAM. 75 discipline-specific National Resource Centres (NRCs) have been identified in the first phase, which are tasked to prepare online training material with focus on latest developments in the discipline, new & emerging trends, pedagogical improvements and methodologies for transacting revised curriculum. ARPIT will be an ongoing exercise so that every year NRCs will continuously develop new refresher module in their earmarked discipline each year. The training materials will be uploaded and made available through SWAYAM. NRC will publish the list of the faculty who have been certified. The NRCs will revolutionize professional development of faculty by catering to massive numbers by leveraging ICT and online technology platform of SWAYAM. Certification will be issued to all successful candidates based upon the grading system. This programme has PAN India participation. It gets reflected in the credits.

This year under ARPIT the Department of Architecture is running a Course titled "Emerging areas in Hospital Planning, Design, Construction and Management". The 40 module course is being conducted by Dr.Anil Dewan, Professor of Architecture. As on date of Meeting, 1027 candidates have registered for the course.

Director-Chairman emphasised the need for more publicity of this programme.

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HOD(Arch.) presented the agenda to modify the Ordinance-II - Ph.D Regulations, 2018 admission to Ph.D programme, Clause 4. He informed the Senate that for admission to full Ph.D programme, a candidate with Bachelor's Degree in Arch/Planning of the Bachelor Degree in Civil Engg. or its equivalent, the minimum requirement of 70% attemption and the Bachelor Degree in Civil Engg. or its equivalent, the minimum requirement of 70% attemption and the with Master's Degree, the minimum requirement of aggregate marks is 55 per cent Candidates with 5 years Integrated Courses with 55% marks are admitted by PG departments whereas the UG departments have to reject/refuse admission to deserving and the professional experience.

On this, some of the Senate Members opined that there should be uniformity in metaloge for both UG and PG candidates. It was further emphasised that B.Arch is a messional programme and three years professional experience gives enough knowledge to measure the Ph.D programme.

Some of the Senate Members were, however, not in favour of downgrading the

Dean(Academics) informed the Senate that during last Senate held on 24.04.2019, this was raised and it was advised to the Department to bring the proposed amendments in existing rules and the comparative statement with other SPAs for discussions at length. However, the Department has not put up any comparative statement so far.

He further presented a comparison statement with SPA(V), SPA(B), MANIT, Jaipur and IT(R) etc. and opined that percentage should not be lowered.

The Senate noted the report on the Diamond Jubilee celebrations of the Department of Housing. The Department was set-up way back in the year 1958 and has completed 60 years. On this occasion, several senior Alumnus were felicitated. In addition, an Exhibition on SEVEN DECADES OF HOUSING was conducted. Also, a NATIONAL HOUSING CONFERENCE was conducted. The meet attracted nearly 150 persons from all over the country and was a grand success.

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ANY OTHER ITEMS:

1. Prof.Dr.V.K.Paul requested that the Department of BEM intends to set up Centre for Fire Studies. The Department has conducted various training programmes on Capacity Building etc. Director-Chairman informed that while this is welcome, the School is facing space-crunch and no extra space is available. It was also informed that School shall not be able to provide any funds for the Centre. The Senate approved, in principle, the setting up of a Centre for Fire Studies and requested Prof.Dr.V.K.Paul to put up a detailed proposal for approval in the next Senate Meeting.

Director-Chairman, requested all faculty to forward proposals, if any, on emergent areas of concern for possible setting up of Centres as needed.

- 2. HOD(PP) informed that the admission for B.Plan and B.Arch courses in many colleges of India is through a common admission test, i.e., Paper 2 of Joint Entrance Examination (JEE). The Entrance exam contained three sections a) Mathematics b) Aptitude c) drawing. From JEE 2020, students appearing for Bachelor of Planning will have a section of Planning aptitude instead of drawing. Taking into account the multidisciplinary nature of B.Planning course which encompasses knowledge from various fields like economics, geography, environmental science, mathematics, etc., B.Planning will continue to consider students from all streams who have mathematics. Therefore, students of commerce and humanities stream with mathematics are eligible for admission to B.Plan through Paper 2 (B.Plan section). Any science stream student with mathematics is eligible to appear for Paper 2, both B.Arch and B.Plan sections.
- 3. HOD(TP) raised the issue that the Ph.D External Examiners (out of India) should be paid honorarium. On this it was clarified that this being a financial matter, it could be considered by FC and not the Senate.
- 4. The issue regarding recovery of double payments made to Ms.Chetna Singh (Ref. Item 26(6) of the 4th Senate) was raised by Prof.Dr.Vinita Yadav. On this, Director-Chairman explained that a sum of Rs.27,923/- (principal + interest) had already been recovered and the matters stands closed. 

The admission for B.Plan and B.Arch courses in many colleges of India is through a common admission test, i.e., Paper 2 of Joint Entrance Examination (JEE). The Entrance exam contained three sections a) Mathematics b) Aptitude c) drawing. From JEE 2020, students appearing for Bachelor of Planning will have a section of Planning aptitude instead of drawing. Taking into account the multidisciplinary nature of B.Planning course which encompasses knowledge from various fields like economics, geography, environmental science, mathematics, etc., B.Planning will continue to consider students from all streams who have mathematics.
