

06 SENATE ITEM NO.1:	THE SCHOOL HELD ON 04 <sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER, 2019

The Minutes of the 05<sup>th</sup> Senate Committee Meeting held on 4<sup>th</sup> October, 2019 were confirmed, with the comments received from Prof.Dr.Aruna Ramani Grover, Prof.Dr.Mayank Mathur, Prof.Dr.Mahavir and Prof.Dr.Poonam Prakash.

O6 SENATE ITEM NO.2:	SENATE MEETING OF THE SCHOOL HELD ON 04 OCTOBER

Ar.Shirish Govind Sukhatme inquired about the remuneration paid to Contract Faculty appointed by the School and emphasised that salary of 365 days should be paid to them comparable with the salary & perks paid to regular faculty. He further advised that the Contract Faculty should be appointed for a tenure of 2 years.

On this Director-Chairman, informed that the MHRD is looking into the matter of revision of COA Norms on Architectural Education. He stated that the appointment of Contract Faculty is made for 11 months as prevailing practice in this regard. It was further clarified that COA norms are followed on the qualification and the requirement of contract faculty. He further

informed that the Representative from COA was invited for making selection to the confaculty.

With the above, the action taken report on the Minutes of the 05<sup>th</sup> Senate Meeting on 4<sup>th</sup> October, 2019 was approved by the Senate.

O6 SENATE ITEM NO.3:

TO CONSIDER AMENDMENT IN PH.D RULES / ORDINANCE NO ON PH.D REGULATIONS

Prof.Dr.Sewa Ram, Coordinator of Ph.D Programmes explained the report of t Committee highlighting all amendments proposed in the existing Ph.D rules.

Director-Chairman informed the Senate that the object of the amendment in the Ph.Rules is to be more liberal and open to attract more number of candidates and to give fair opportunity to candidates from allied areas.

As regards clause 5.4 regarding conversion from Full Time to Part Time course, it we clarified that duration is counted based on the request. It was clarified that Full Time Physicholars are not allowed to work and are eligible for scholarship as per rules and they have assist in teaching in the concerned department. For Part Time, scholars can work in the School or outside School and can receive salary. On this it was inquired how many times the change is allowed and how the duration shall be counted after change over. Clarification this regard was also given.

Prof.Dr.B.K.Sengupta inquired about the credit requirement for B.Arch students at the M.Arch students. It was clarified that for B.Arch, credits including Research Methodolo is 12 for scholars with B.Arch and 6 credits for M.Arch scholars. He emphasised the exceptionally bright candidates with Bachelor's Degree in Architecture/Planning be allowed entry into Ph.D programme.

It was informed to Senate that School is not forwarding the thesis reports of the scholars who have not published the research papers, as required under the Ph.D rules.

The Senate approved the report of the 3-Member Committee under the Chairmansh of Prof.Dr.Sewa Ram, with minor additions/deletions, as under:

- a) In clause 5.4(c) To be added "Request of Scholar can be considered only once."
- b) In clause 4.1b1, 4.1 b2 & 4.1.c Word 'minimum' to be added before required years of experience

The Senate resolved to approve the amendment in PH.D rules and accordingly the Ordinance No.II On Ph.D Regulations and also authorised Chairman, Senate to implement an other minor correction, if required in this regard.

06 SENATE ITEM NO.4:

TO CONSIDER SETTING UP OF CENTER FOR FIRE STUDIES IN THE DEPARTMENT OF BUILDING ENGG. AND MANAGEMENT

The Senate approved the setting up of the Centre for Fire Studies in the Department of Building Engg. & Management without any financial liability on the School.

06 SENATE ITEM NO.5:

TO CONSIDER SETTING UP OF CENTRE FOR SHARED & ELECTRIC MOBILITY STUDIES IN THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT PLANNING

Director-Chairman, requested all faculty to forward proposals, if any, on emergent areas of concern for possible setting up of Centres as needed.

The Senate approved the setting up of the Centre for Shared & Electric Mobility Studies in the Department of Transport Planning without any financial liability on the School.
