Existing Rule 7.8

In case a Supervisor/Co-supervisor informs the unavailability to guide or resigns, retires or dies, his replacement shall be promptly arranged by the Chairperson DRC.

Proposed Rule 7.8

In case a Supervisor/Co-supervisor informs the unavailability to guide or resigns, retires or dies or goes on leave for 12 months or more, his or her replacement shall be promptly arranged by the Chairperson DRC. However, if the Supervisor desires to continue to supervise after retirement, he/she may do so, but as a Co-Supervisor.

The Senate approved the same.

The Director-Chairman stated that there is a long pending need of the School to expand its academic horizons and initiate courses in new and emerging disciplines. It was stated that while several Masters degree courses were already approved by the School, the same could not be started on account of shortage of space. In such a situation, it was felt that initiating weekend programmes of a shorter duration could be a viable option. It was also stated that this way, working professionals could attend these programmes over the weekends and space would also be more optimally utilized. The Senate deliberated in detail about various issues regarding the proposed diploma



courses and suggested that this is a very good initiative and should be taken forward at the earliest.

Further, it was also advised that the proposed courses shall correlate with the SPA Vision as well as the NEP 2020, should be in emerging niche areas, should encompass built environment, natural environment, technology, policy and governance. It was also suggested that collaborations on a case to case basis could be considered.

It was agreed that there would be many details to be worked out viz. themes of the diploma courses, syllabus, scheme of examination, rules, fees, faculty/visiting faculty, etc. and therefore, the same should be initiated. It was also suggested that a Committee to work out all these details should be constituted by the Director.

The proposal put up was approved in principle.

The Senate considered and approved the selection criteria with minor modifications for admission to Integrated M.Planning Programme, after third year, as under:

Only students admitted from 2019 onwards will be considered

- Completion of the entire integrated course in seven years (maximum) is mandatory
- Selection of students will be merit based and CGPA from first to sixth semester will be considered for the same. A minimum of 5.5 CGPA should be obtained till sixth semester.
- To be considered for selection, all carry overs should be cleared till sixth semester. There should be no carry over in fifth and sixth semester.

Once a student is selected based on the above criteria, it will be mandatory for them to clear seventh semester without any carry over to ensure actual admission in the Integrated M. Planning course. In case of a carry over, admission will not be given for Integrated Semester and the next candidate in the wait list will be selected.

The Senate approved the following detailed guidelines for the award:

a. The award may be known as Late Prof. M. N. Chatterji Award.

b. The award may be awarded to a student of Fourth Year, Bachelor of Planning or Integrated Master of Planning, who secures highest marks in the subject 'Planning Theory -I' and 'Planning Theory - II' combined together, of B. Planning examination, clearing in first attempt.

c. A student, who clears the examination in second attempt or has a carryover or break in studies, or a disciplinary action against him/ her, will not

be considered for the award.

d. The award may be given on recommendation of the Head of the Department of Physical Planning, based on a Committee of faculty, and approved by the Director.

e. The award may be awarded on the Foundation day of the School.

- f. The award will be in the form of books, worth upto Rs.5,000/-, relevant to the subject Planning Theory, as decided by the Head of the Department of Physical Planning in consultation with the faculty concerned teaching the subject.
- g. An amount of Rs.1,50,000/- shall be contributed as an Endowment from the Department of Physical Planning Consultancy PDF. The endowment can be further topped up by contributions form faculty and/ or other professionals from outside the School.

h. The interest generated on the above shall be utilised, upto Rs.5,000/-every year, to purchase and award books.

TO CONSIDER THE LATE PROF.L.R. VAGALE AWARD

The Senate was informed that the late Prof. L.R. Vagale Award was approved by the erstwhile AC/EC of the School several years ago and that an amount of Rs. 50,000 was also deposited by Prof; Vagale for the same but somehow, the award was not given till date.

The Senate considered and agreed to revive/initiate the award at the earliest in the memory of Prof. L. R. Vagale, former Head of the Department of Town and Country Planning out of donation amount of Rs.50,000/- donated by Prof. Vagale himself in 2006.

Further, it was agreed and approved that *Prof.L.R.Vagale Award may be awarded to a student of Master of Planning (Regional Planning)*, (instead of *Master of Planning (Urban) or Master of Planning (Regional)*, as initially proposed in the agenda and the *Prof.N.S.Saini Award may be awarded to a student of Master of Planning (Urban)*.

The following detailed guidelines for the Prof.L.R.Vagale Award were approved as under:

a. The award may be known as Late Prof. L. R. Vagale Award.

b. The award may be awarded to a student of *Master of Planning (Regional)*, who secures highest marks in Thesis, of M. Planning (Regional) examination, clearing in first attempt.

c. A student, who clears the examination in second attempt or has a carryover or break in studies, or a disciplinary action against him/her, will not

be considered for the award.

d. The award may be given on recommendation of the Head of the Department of Regional Planning, based on a Committee of faculty, and approved by the Director.

e. The award may be awarded on the Foundation day of the School.

f. The award will be in the form of books, worth upto Rs.5,000/-, as selected by the student and approved by the Director.

g. The amount of Award to be met out of the annual interest on the endowment left by Late Prof. L. R. Vagale. The endowment can be further topped up by contributions form faculty and/ or other professionals from outside the School.
