In supersession of the earlier Notices dated 09th August 2024, the Ph.D. Fee is notified as under. All the existing Ph.D. Scholars of the School are required to pay the following fees and other charges for the Academic Session 2024-25 (Enrolled in January Session) upto 10th June, 2025 as per the detail given below:

The above payment is to be made through the following process:

1. SBI Collect website www.onlinesbi.com, selecting NCT Delhi, then Educational Institution, then School of Planning and Architecture, New Delhi.

OR

2. SPA, New Delhi website www.spa.ac.in FEE and PAYMENT LINK in Admission column.

STUDENTS WHO HAVE PAID EXCESS FEE MAY APPLY FOR REFUND THROUGH THEIR RESPECTIVE HEAD OF THE DEPARTMENT.



If any student fails to deposit his/her prescribed fees (Balance Fee) by 10th June, 2025, the fees shall be accepted with a fine of Rs. 50/- per day up to 17th June, 2025. After that, no fee will be accepted, and the name of such a student will be struck off from the rolls of the School. However, such student may be re-admitted up to 20th June, 2025, on payment of Rs.4,000/- as re-admission charges along with the prescribed fees and fine, with the prior approval of the competent authority of the School.

All students are required to submit proof of fees paid in their concerned Department of Studies to make entries in the Fee Collection Register. On completion of the register, the concerned Departmental official shall submit it to his/her Controlling Officer for verification, as it is auditable.

The Heads of the Departments of Studies are requested to ensure that all the students have paid their fees, and if any student has not paid the fees, the same may please be brought to the notice of the Assistant Registrar of the Accounts and Budget Section & Assistant Registrar of the Admission Section latest by 25th June, 2025.
